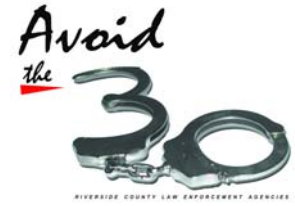

MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND AVOID CAMPAIGN – FINAL UPDATE**

Did YOU AVOID the 30?

The Memorial Day Weekend DUI crackdown on drinking drivers has resulted in a large number of DUI arrests from the Sobriety Checkpoints, Special Saturation Patrols and routine patrol in the Riverside County “AVOID” DUI Campaign.

******From 12:01 a.m., Friday, May 23, 2008, through Midnight, Monday, May 25, 2008, officers representing 30 county law enforcement agencies have arrested 121* individuals for driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Tragically, there was at least one death, in Coachella, attributed to drunk driving during the reporting period. Another traffic collision near Indio, which claimed three deaths, is still under investigation and may not have been DUI-related. (*NOTE: These numbers are only provisional with many agencies yet to report**)

County Law Enforcement officials conducted DUI Checkpoints in Desert Hot Springs and Riverside. Saturation Patrols were conducted in Banning, Coachella, Corona, Hemet, La Quinta, Riverside, San Jacinto, and Thermal.

Avoid programs, named for the number of police agencies in each county, also concentrate on the Independence Day weekend as well as the 17-day August/Labor Day period. In recognition that summer season is among the deadliest time of the year, law enforcement agencies throughout the county will be making every effort to arrest drunk drivers before another life is lost.


